FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. WHAT IS SUPER LOTTO?

Super Lotto is a block lottery game that is played across more than one national border. In this case, the borders span the Caribbean. It is a multi-jurisdictional game similar to PowerBall, Euromillions or Megamillions, in which sales of different countries or jurisdictions join together to allow for a Super Jackpot game. Super Lotto will have a starting jackpot of US\$2 million, converted to each country's local currency.

It is really a mega 'lotto' type game similar to the local Lotto game offered by Supreme Ventures Limited. The difference is, instead of the pool of players coming from one territory, the pool is extended to several territories.

2. HOW IS THIS POSSIBLE?

This has been made possible through the technology network of our service provider GTECH Corporation. All the participating countries are currently operating on the GTECH platform and so the synergy to link sales across national borders has been made easier.

3. WHICH CARIBBEAN ISLANDS WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN SUPER LOTTO?

- a. There are currently 7 Caribbean islands participating in the Super Lotto game, with the option of other territories joining in.
- b. The participating islands at the start are Dominican Republic, Jamaica, Barbados, St Kitts, Anguilla, Antigua, St. Maarten

4. WHAT IS THE TICKET PRICE?

- a. The ticket will be priced at \$250 Jamaican dollars.

5. WHAT IS THE STARTING JACKPOT?

- a. The jackpot starts at J\$180M (equivalent of US\$2M)

6. HOW WILL THE JACKPOT GROW?

- a. Like a regular Lotto game, the super Lotto jackpot will grow until there is a winner.
- b. If there is no winner, the jackpot will roll over until there is a winner.

7. HOW IS SUPER LOTTO PLAYED?

- a. The player will select a total of six (6) numbers as follows;:
 - i. **First** - Choose 5 numbers between 1 and 35
 - ii. **Second** - Choose 1 additional number '**the Super Ball**' from a second selection between numbers 1 and 35.

8. HOW CAN I WIN?

- a. The player wins the jackpot by matching the 5 numbers drawn, plus the Super Ball.
- b. Note that the Super Ball **must** be drawn to win the jackpot.
- c. The other prize levels are as follows:
 - i. Match 5 + 0

- ii. Match 4 + 1 (Super Ball)
- iii. Match 4 + 0
- iv. Match 3 + 1(Super Ball)
- v. Match 3 + 0

9. WHERE AND WHEN DO I BUY TICKETS?

- a. Tickets can be purchased in any of the participating Caribbean countries on local lottery sales days.
- b. In Jamaica, tickets are available at all Supreme Ventures locations island-wide between Monday and Saturday of each week.

10. WHAT IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE WINNER?

- a. The game is pari-mutuel like Lotto; therefore prizes are shared between all winners. The jackpot will be shared across all winners, regardless of island, however, the lower level prizes in Jamaica, will be shared between players in Jamaica only

11. WILL THERE BE A WINNER IN EVERY COUNTRY?

- a. The game will be played in 7 islands within the Caribbean and the jackpot winner(s) may come from any island.

12. CAN I VALIDATE MY TICKET IN ANY OF THE ISLANDS?

- a. Super Lotto tickets can only be validated in the country where the ticket was purchased. The system will not allow validations across territories.
- b. Each ticket must be validated within 90 days of the draw just like the other Supreme Ventures games.

13. WHERE CAN PRIZE AMOUNTS BE COLLECTED?

- a. Similar to all other local lottery games, prize payout locations will vary based on the value of the prize:
 - i. **Agent Locations:** Maximum \$49,999
 - ii. **SVL Regional Centers:** \$50,000 to \$299,999
 - iii. **SVL Prize Payment Center:** All amounts above \$300,000

14. WHEN WILL THE DRAWS TAKE PLACE?

- a. The Super Lotto draws will be aired twice weekly - on Tuesdays and Fridays at 9:30pm on CVM and IRIE FM
- b. **Note:** Pools for Super Lotto, like all other SVL games, will close at 7:25pm each day.

15. WILL I BE ABLE TO PURCHASE QUICK PICK TICKETS?

- a. Yes. The system will randomly select the 5 numbers and the Super Ball

16. CAN THE SUPER LOTTO TICKET BE CANCELLED?

- a. Similar to Lotto and Lucky 5, you cannot cancel a Super Lotto ticket once printed from the terminal, so players are encouraged to use the bet slips for number selection.

17. WILL THE SUPER LOTTO PRIZES BE TAXED?-

Prizes will be paid net of all applicable taxes e.g. Jamaica's Bets Winning Tax of 15% will be applied to all prize amounts \$15,000 and over.
